Position Summary

ʕaahʕuusʔath First Nation is seeking **four (4) Qwaahmahsaqin Cultural Support Workers**, one in each designated service area.

This is a **remote position**, however, candidates **must reside within their assigned service area**. Regular travel within the service area is required to provide direct, in-community cultural support to members.

This role centers on facilitating cultural supports, strengthening connections to teachings and practices, and working alongside members in a respectful, culturally grounded, and trauma-informed way. The ideal candidate brings strong interpersonal skills, self-motivation, and a deep understanding of ʕaahʕuusʔath cultural protocols.

Key Responsibilities

- Promote and support traditional cultural teachings and practises for ʕaahʕuusʔath members.
- Engage in collaborative community partnerships to promote traditional healing, teachings, and protocols.
- Build and maintain supportive, trusting relationships with members
- Facilitate and coordinate culturally relevant programming and activities
- Travel within the service area to provide in-person support

- Collaborate with internal teams and community partners to strengthen culturally grounded services
- Liaise with Elders, Knowledge Keepers, and leadership to ensure appropriate protocols are followed
- Apply trauma-informed and culturally safe approaches in all interactions
- Maintain accurate documentation and uphold strict confidentiality
- Prepare detailed reports and provide program data as required
- Serve as a role model and mentor within the community

Qualifications & Experience

- High school diploma or equivalent (required)
- Strong knowledge of Ahousaht cultural teachings, ceremonial protocols, and leadership practices
- Experience working in wellness, community, or culturally grounded environments
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively within a culturally centered framework
- Certificate or degree in Indigenous Studies or a related field is considered an asset

Conditions of Employment

- Must reside within the designated service area
- Valid driver's license
- Successful completion of an RCMP Criminal Record Check, including Vulnerable Sector Clearance
- Ability to sign and adhere to confidentiality agreements and organizational policies
- Required to follow all Ƴaaḥuusḡath Personnel Policies, Code of Ethics, and reporting protocols

Working Conditions

This role requires flexibility, cultural awareness, and the ability to respond to complex situations:

Physical Demands:

- Extended periods of sitting, standing, and computer use
- Lifting up to 30 lbs and physical movement (bending, reaching, lifting, stairs)
- Ability to respond to high-risk or crisis situations

Environmental Conditions:

- Remote work combined with frequent travel within the service area
- Work in both indoor and outdoor environments, across all seasons
- Exposure to unpredictable or crisis situations requiring timely response

Sensory & Mental Demands:

- Participation in ceremonies involving traditional medicines
- Exposure to challenging environments, including individuals in crisis or experiencing substance use
- Managing multiple priorities, deadlines, and emotionally demanding situations
- Maintaining high attention to detail in reporting and documentation
